

Nominating Committee Report for the 2026 Annual General Meeting of CPRS Calgary

August 10, 2026

Each program year, in accordance with the CPRS Calgary By-laws (Article V) and Regulations (Article IV), the Board of the Society appoints a Nominating Committee including no less than the President and the President-Elect and/or Past President. In 2026, the nomination committee consists of:

- Lisa Rushka, APR, FCPRS – President
- Peter Ryan, APR – Past President
- Richard Truscott, APR, FCPRS – Treasurer

There are currently 2 voting positions open. Please note, according to CPRS Calgary By-laws, “No member shall be eligible to hold office on the Board unless he or she has been a member in good standing for at least 12 months.” The Nominating Committee has deemed that CPRS Calgary should actively seek to fill:

- Membership Chair
- Secretary

Nominations for the Board of Directors may be made up to two (2) weeks/14 days prior to the Calgary Society’s Annual General Meeting. Members in good standing may nominate themselves or be nominated by another member in good standing. All nominations must be made in writing, signed by the nominator and nominee, and submitted to the President and Past President (president@cprscalgary.com and pastpresident@cprscalgary.com) **no later than August 27, 2026.**

Once convened under the guidance of the CPRS Calgary President for the 2026-2027 program year, the Board will evaluate its structure to ensure that Board members have the support they need to fulfill their respective roles, and that CPRS Calgary is carefully managing workload to ensure the structure is sustainable.

CPRS Calgary Board members are required to serve a two-year term (and can serve up to three consecutive terms), with a commitment of one in-person meeting per month.
